

BOARD RESOLUTION OF GEORGIA CIVIL WAR COMMISSION

ACKNOWLEDGING GEORGIA STATE CODE 50-3-1

Upon motion, duly seconded, the following resolution was adopted:

WHEREAS, the Georgia Civil War Commission was created by the 1993 Georgia General Assembly with its mandate, as spelled out in Senate Resolution 21, to coordinate planning, preservation, and promotion of structures, buildings, sites, and battlefields associated with this significant period of our common heritage; and

WHEREAS, one of the reasons the Georgia Civil War Commission was created was to protect and preserve structures of the Civil War era, which include the Confederate monuments and memorials that dot our state's landscape; and

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Georgia Civil War Commission supports the current Georgia State Code 50-3-1 as written, with no amendments, which protects all war memorials and monuments across the state; and
